I will have a serious illness conversation with all my patients with a 1-2 year prognosis as a standard practice.

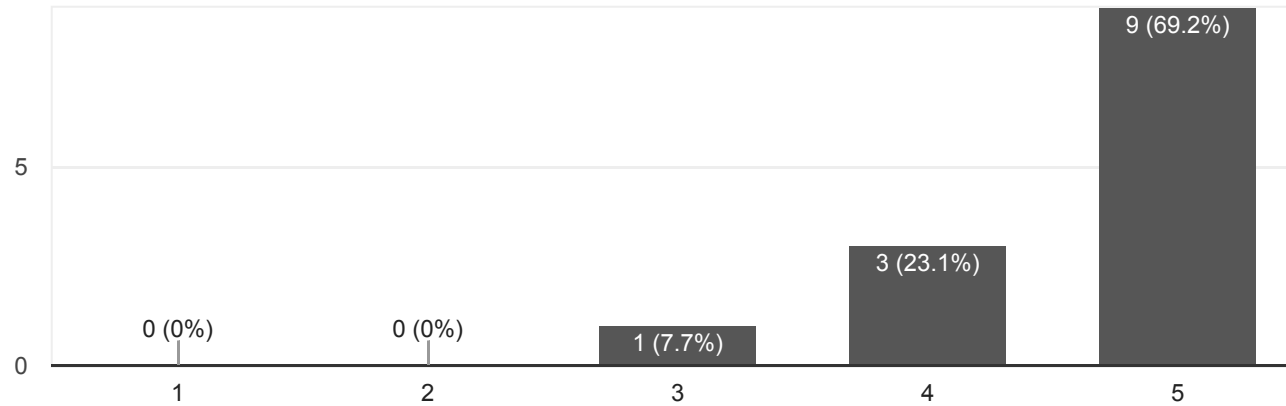
using a structured QA system

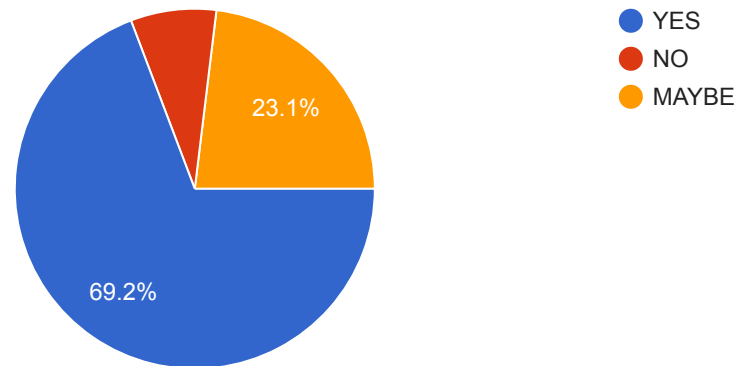
